Reed Business School offers the following course options for ACCA students:

Full Link

- Three phase course consisting of introductory and interim courses covering whole syllabus
- Revision course (see below)
- Correspondence full syllabus link examination paper and marking
- Progress reports sent to employers (please complete relevant section on enrolment form to opt out of this option)

Revision

- A technical overview of the syllabus focussing on exam question practice & technique required to pass
- Revision mock examination/question based day at the end of the course
- Essentials Paper 2 (corporate reporting) revision courses will be split into 2 x three day blocks (including QBD) due to the technical demands of the subject. This will allow students time to 'get to grips' with the first three days' content before completing the remainder of the course and attempting the QBD

Question based days (Professional papers only)

- Practice of unseen questions in examination conditions with experienced markers and tutor feedback

Computer Based Examinations (CBE)

The Business school is licensed to run the ACCA CBE for Knowledge papers F1, F2 and F3. We have timetabled these to run shortly after the relevant December 2009 revision courses. Students can attend our teaching and revision courses to prepare for either the CBE or written examinations. Please complete the relevant section on the enrolment form if you wish to sit the CBE at Reed.

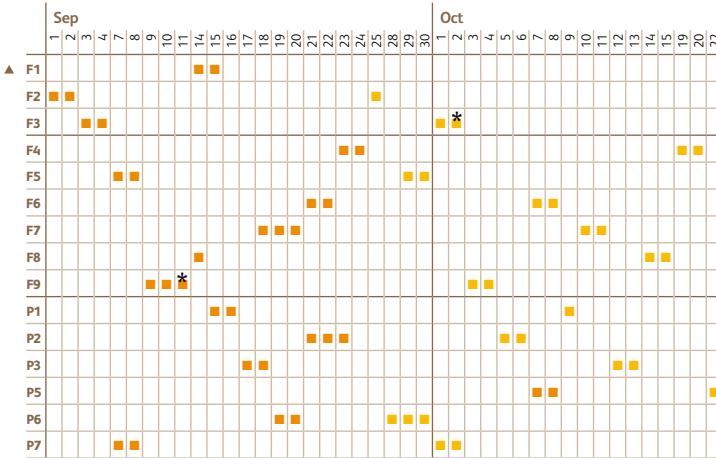

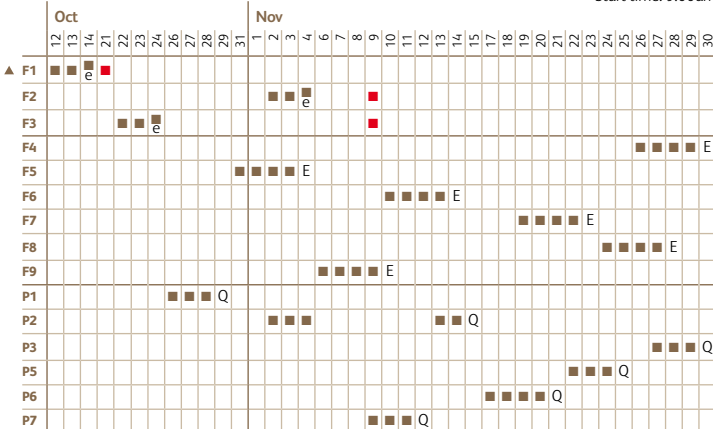
